Tourism Department Utilizing CARES ACT Grant Funds to Promote Hamblen County As SAFE Destination

As our community's Destination Marketing Organization (DMO), the Chamber is working with the State of Tennessee Department of Tourism to utilize grant funds to promote Morristown and Hamblen County as a safe place to visit. This "SAFEcation" marketing plan will communicate the message that travelers can safely visit Morristown and Hamblen County. The program was recently rolled out by the state, utilizing CARES ACT funds and must be implemented before the end of the year.

Some elements of the plan include the development of a micro website with the URL safecationmorristowntn.com, a 4-month Google ad campaign, a 4 month social media campaign, Visit Morristown TN branded face masks and hand sanitizer giveaways for hotels and restaurants, development of videos highlighting our outdoor activities, and billboards on I-81 in southwest Virginia and I-75 in north Georgia.
