When the Commission was Chartered in 1901, James Mathes became the Second Assistant Engineer making \$30 a month. He spent the next two years learning everything he could about the Power and Water industries and in 1903 became the first ever General Manager. During his tenure, he built a strong Commission that the community came to trust and rely on. Water quality was improved by the building of Havley Springs Filter Plant and in 1926, the Holston Steam Power Plant was built under his direction to provide the power and water needed for the growing population. Under Mr. Mathes leadership, the Commission entered its first Power Contract with TVA and a few years later, its first long term Power Contract, ensuring that Morristown received enough power for the future.

In 1947, Mr. Mathes recommended to the Board that they start looking for his replacement as he felt that he no longer was able to carry on the duties of GM as they should be. In December 1948, Mr. Mathes asked to be relieved as GM after 47 years of service. He continued to assist the Commission until his death a few months later. On February 18, 1949, Mr. Mathes passed away while at his desk at the Commissions office.

IT'S TIME TO INSPECT YOUR HOME FOR FIRE HAZARDS

This the perfect time to inspect your home for fire hazards. Here's what to look for:

- Old wiring and overloaded electrical circuits
- Worn or damaged outlets and cords and plugs on lamps and appliances
- ☑ Extension cords run under rugs
- Faulty heating systems, e.g., has your heating system been professionally serviced and checked this year? Is your chimney clean if you intend to use a fireplace or woodstove this winter?
- Kitchen appliances and power tools left plugged in when not in use
- Appliances that spark, smoke, or smell when turned on
- Containers of flammable substances, such as gas for the mower, not tightly sealed in appropriate containers or stored near heat or ignition sources
- ☑ Too many appliances or tools plugged into the same outlet
- ☑ Oily rags left lying around in the workshop or broom closet
- ☑ Smoke detectors with old or no batteries
- No family emergency plan for evacuation in case of a fire, or no recent fire drill to practice evacuation procedures

Every home is vulnerable to fire. Yours could go up in flames, along with the items you've worked so hard to own, unless you and your family take fire safety precautions and inspect regularly for fire hazards.

Safety Snips

A Look at Eye Safety

October is Eye Injury Prevention Month

Studies show that the two main reasons American workers suffer eye injuries are:

- They weren't wearing any eye protection.
- 2. They were wearing the wrong kind of protection.

These findings give you a clue about what to focus on to prevent eye injuries. You also need to identify all the eye hazards in your job, which could include:

- Impact—from flying chips, particles, sand, and dirt, etc.
- Burns—from sparks, molten metal, or chemical splashes
- Irritation—from chemical vapors or dust
- Effects of light radiation—from welding and similar operations

Next, you need to select the right eye protection for the job. The wrong kind may be worse than no protection in some cases. So make sure you know which safety eyewear protects against which hazards. For example:

- a. Safety glasses with side shields or goggles provide good protection against impact hazards.
- Questing at delicate eye tissue.
- A face shield worn over safety eyewear provides extra protection from flying particles and chemical splashes.
- a. Goggles worn with a face shield protect against burn hazards.
- a. Welding goggles with special lenses protect eye tissue by filtering out harmful light radiation.

Finally, follow these safe work practices when eye hazards may be present:

- → Obey all warning signs requiring eye protection.
- → Always put on eye protection before entering an area where hazards may be present.
- → Assume eye hazards are present whenever you're not sure.
- → Make sure eye protection fits properly and comfortably.
- → Inspect protective eyewear for damage before each use, and replace it immediately if there is any defect.
- → Ask your supervisor if you're not sure which type of eye protection is required.

It's flu season and in #2020, our Occupational Health team is preparing to help your team with influenza needs.

Conducting an occupational health on-site influenza (flu) vaccination program with Fast Pace Health is easy. Your organization and community as a whole can utilize our clinic for this flu season or speak directly to our occupational health service team about potential opportunities for a scheduled one-day on-site flu vaccination day (dependent on clinic staffing).

These flu vaccinations incur no additional fees and shots are \$35 and \$75 (65 years and up). Billing and insurance plans can be directly discussed with our occupational health service team today.

Vaccines will be administered by immunization-trained Fast Pace Health providers. On-site flu vaccination day length is determined by the rate of 12 immunizations per hour, per provider. The Fast Pace Health providers will be equipped with N95 masks on-site during the visit and will come prepared with needed quantities for administering vaccines to all scheduled employees.

What will Fast Pace Health Providers bring to an on-site flu vaccination day?

Fast Pace providers will bring vaccines and other materials necessary for administering vaccines according to immunization protocol. Providers will also be equipped with N95 masks.

Needed items are a private room or area, table, and chairs.

Fast Pace Health requests to be notified if an outbreak related to influenza (flu) or other illness occur at your facility.

What do I need to do to schedule for an on-site flu vaccination day?

Please reach out to the Fast Pace Occupational Health service team to discuss the set-up of an on-site flu vaccination day and they will assist with answering additional questions and details.

If available in your area, Fast Pace Health will begin arrangements to staff your one-day flu vaccination day. Additional details will be provided from our occupational health team.

Should any employee miss the opportunity to obtain a flu shot on the scheduled date of the one-day flu vaccination day, they may obtain a shot at our local clinic at a later date as part of your occupational health services.

What about insurance coverage?

Fast Pace Health accepts most major insurance plans. Patients are urged to contact their health plan to learn if the influenza (flu) vaccination will be covered at Fast Pace Health. In many instances this service is fully covered.

What is Stigma? Why is it a Problem?

Stigma is when someone, or even you yourself, views a person in a negative way just because they have a mental health condition. Some people describe stigma as a feeling of shame or

judgement from someone else. Stigma can even come from an internal place, confusing *feeling* bad with *being* bad. Navigating life with a mental health condition can be tough, and the isolation, blame and secrecy that is often encouraged by stigma can create huge challenges to reaching out, getting needed support, and living well. Learning how to avoid and address stigma are important for all of us, especially when you realize stigma's effects:

- People experiencing mental health conditions often face rejection, bullying and discrimination. This can make their journey to recovery longer and more difficult.
- Mental health conditions are the leading cause of disability across the United States.
- Even though most people can be successfully treated, less than half of the adults in the U.S. who need services and treatment get the help they need.
- The average delay between the onset of symptoms and intervention is 8-10 years.

Suicide is the second leading cause of death of youth ages 15-24 and the tenth leading cause of death for all Americans.
