



Walters State Seeking Input on Spanish Certificate Program

Walters State Community College is gathering letters of support and survey data to start a Spanish Certificate program at WSCC, which would be the first in the state should it be approved by the Tennessee Board of Regents. Below is more information about this certificate program. Any businesses/industries in the area who are interested in supporting this

program are encouraged to complete the survey below and/or send an email of support.

The idea for this certificate started several years ago when we noticed needs in our service area for Spanish-speakers. At the time we did not do a survey of need or interest, but we are now reaching out to local area businesses and industries to determine the level of need and support in our service area. My hope is that this certificate will help students and workers in our area to build Spanish-speaking skills to improve and broaden communication within businesses and industries in our area.

The Spanish Certificate will be an 18-credit hour (6 classes) program. It requires students to take the four basic Spanish classes (Elementary Spanish I through Intermediate Spanish II), Culture of the Spanish-speaking world, and one specialty class (Hospitality Spanish, Medical Spanish, or Special Topics which can focus on other areas as needed). It can be completed in one year if the student begins with Elementary Spanish I in the first 5-week summer session and continues straight through. It can also be spread out if needed to work with another degree. If a student comes in with previous experience in studying Spanish, they can take the CLEP test or Prior Learning Assessment to possibly earn college credits and lessen the number to classes that need to be taken since the credits from those tests would count as college credit for required classes. At the end of the program students can opt to take a Spanish fluency exam to establish their fluency level. There is an extra cost associated with this exam.

If you have further questions or would like to discuss this in person or via phone/Zoom, please do not hesitate to contact Erika Stevens, Ed.D. at Walters State. If you are still interested, I would ask that you complete the Survey of Community Need by clicking on the link below. If you could also send me a letter of support via email stating that you feel that this is a needed program in our area, that you support this program, and/or that you would encourage/support employees to enroll in this program, I would greatly appreciate it. Also, feel free to forward this information to any other business/industry leaders that might be interested. The more support we receive, the more likely the Tennessee Board of Regents is to approve our application to start this Spanish Certificate as a first of its kind in the state.


