## **Chamber Announces Christmas Parade**



Christmas Parade

The Morristown Area Chamber of Commerce is pleased to announce it will be partnering with **Morristown Pediatric Dentistry** to bring the 2022 Morristown Christmas Parade to the community. This year's parade will be held on Thursday, December 1 in Downtown Morristown. The parade theme will be "Christmas Around the World".

Applications for the Christmas Parade are available at the Chamber office (825 W. First North St.) and on the



Chamber's website, <u>www.morristownchamber.com</u>.

The parade will step off at 7:00 p.m. from the intersection of Hamilton Ave. and West Main St (Across from the Morristown Hamblen Library). The parade will follow the traditional route through Downtown Morristown and disperse in the parking lot at HomeTrust Bank, 120 Evans Ave. Organizations, churches, businesses, school groups and other interested parties are encouraged to pick up a registration form and join the parade.

There is an entry fee for all units entering the parade and registration is required. Fees, key dates and parade rules and regulations are included on the registration form. Deadline to return your parade registration and entry fee is <u>12:00 noon on Thursday</u>, <u>November 10</u>. Late entries will not be accepted. Proof of insurance and a copy of the Drivers License for the individual driving the entry is also required.

"Last year's parade was the largest in recent memory and based on the phone calls and e-mails we have been receiving since June, we anticipate the same interest and enthusiasm this year", according to Chamber General Manager Debra Williams.

Volunteer Marshalls for the Chamber's Parade Planning Committee are Bill Sanders, Mannie Bedwell, and Deborah Aarons. They have been working since May on plans for the 2022 parade to make it a safe and enjoyable event for both participants and spectators. One of their more pleasant tasks was the selection of the Grand Marshall for the Parade. It was a unanimous decision to honor Craig Price who retired as the Director of Parks & Recreation for the City of Morristown in June.

## The Challenge of Child Care

The growth experienced in our community in the past year with new housing development has been unprecedented seeing almost 1,000 new permits pulled in 2021 and we will be on pace for that number again in 2022. This is all from the 3<sup>rd</sup> smallest county in the State of Tennessee. An average year for our community would see us pull around 50 new permits for comparison.

This growth can be a positive stride for us as it helps spread our community's tax burden and affords additional tax revenue to fund items of want and need in our community. With this growth also comes challenges that the Chamber is working to partner and assist in creating solutions.

One main issue isn't a new one at all, but when we add this many more families, it quickly becomes more apparent and that is child care. Our community has a limited number of facilities that are currently stretched thin or at capacity and are also challenged with labor pains. In partnership with Hamblen County Schools, City of Morristown and Hamblen County, we are beginning to address that issue. This challenge is a difficult one when a community like ours has many 24 hour manufacturing and other commercial establishments, so our solution may look much different than many of our surrounding communities. These unique solutions have never been uncommon for our community and the Chamber will always try and assist with these challenges as we continue to see positive growth in our community.


