Captain David Cribley and Geno Hambrick, Transition Team Coordinator with the HCSD, about the new jail. (Due to construction, the class was not able to tour the new jail this year). The class also visited McNabb Center's Jail-to-Work program and visited with alumni of that program.

Following lunch at the City Center, the class got an overview of city government from Assistant City Administrator Andrew Ellard and heard presentations on the new Fire Station #3 from MFD Deputy Chief Anthony Livesay and the Crisis Intervention Team by MPD Det. Shelby Holt.

On Thursday, August 24, the group gathered again at the Hamblen County Courthouse prior to the County Commission meeting and spent about an hour with Commissioner Stan Harville

and Commission Chairman Chris Cutshaw, who gave them an overview of county government and current "hot topic" issues prior to their attendance at the monthly County Commission meeting.
