A "Back to School" Message

As we see our children return to school, I want to take a minute as a parent to prep you for the year ahead. Your child will be pushed and pulled, prodded and poked and forced to perform to ensure some of our higher level elected officials are satisfied with their achievement.

As most of us have noticed, our education system has changed significantly over the last 20 years and more pressure is put on our younger kids now more than ever. We are seeing children subjected to pressure of failure when they should be concentrating on learning and enjoying the education process. They should be learning to speak and communicate, work in a group and how the world really works; instead, the pressure on them is misdirected and will do little to ensure their future success.

To judge all students equally is acceptable, but as some students are freed from the testing pressures depending on their group, school or religion, others are subjected to this testing to determine, in the words of an 8 year old "if they will be a failure their whole life." I encourage you to talk to your kids and explain that success and failure isn't determined by one test, but about the process and the life they lead long after school is complete.

I would offer these elected leaders to take this test with the results made public just to ensure as we vote on items, it is understood that the demographic we are affecting mentally will be the future leaders in their positions and to be a leader, you must be a good follower. To be frank, most businesses, hospitals, law offices, manufacturing companies and other employers rarely ask your 3rd grade TCAP score and while testing to check progress is understandable, to affect a child mentally for the rest of their life is unacceptable.

As elections roll around, it is important to express your thoughts to candidates, as without that advice locally, they get significant pressures at upper levels to conform and if your voice isn't heard, we have little to complain about. Education is the foundation for a community's success at all levels and we should do all in our power to support our schools and children as they enter this new year!
