Health Screenings Offered:

Breast Cancer *

Criteria for these screenings is as follows:

- Age 40+
- At least one year since your last screening mammogram
- No current breast problems (lump, pain, nipple discharge, burning)
- Not pregnant and stopped breastfeeding for at least six months
- No personal history of breast cancer
- Inform us if you have breast implants (will take 2 appointment times)

Lung Cancer *

Criteria for these screenings is as follows:

- Age 50-77 years
- Current smoker or someone who has quit smoking in the last 15 years
- Have a 20 pack-year smoking history (one pack-year = smoking one pack per day for one year; 1 pack = 20 cigarettes)

Gynecological Cancer *

Criteria for these screenings is as follows:

- Women 21-65 years and have not received a screening in the last three years
- Screening should occur sooner if you have a history of abnormal pap smears

Skin Cancer (FREE)

Risk Factors:

- ✓ Fair skin
- ✓ Having red or blonde hair
- ✓ Large, numerous moles
- ✓ History of excessive sun exposure
- ✓ Having a past or family history of skin cancer

Men are encouraged to attend and get screened.

* These screenings require additional coordination prior to the event. Lung screening is free with insurance (prior insurance authorization) or \$199 cash. Breast screening is free with insurance or qualify for grant funding if uninsured. Gynecologic screening is free, however pathology will be billed to patient's insurance or if uninsured will receive a self-pay rate of \$32.

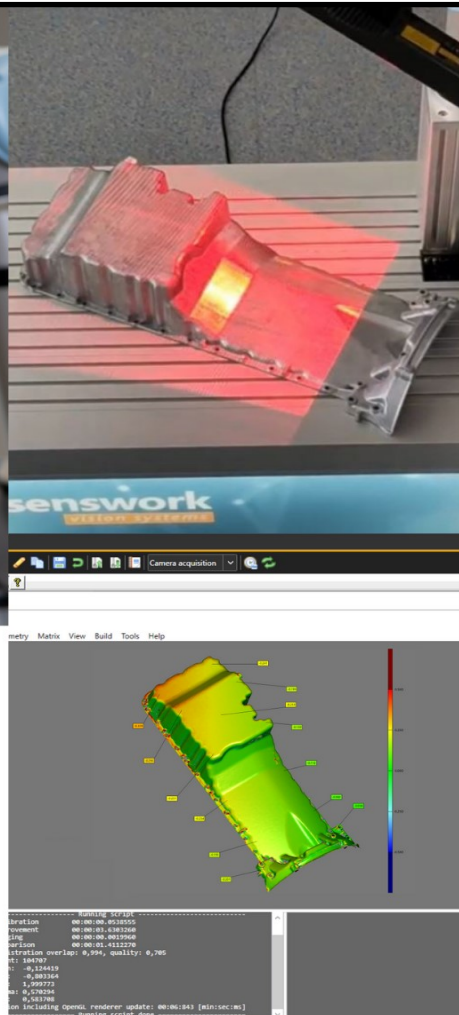

East Tennessee Human Resource Agency (ETHRA) Transportation Hires Marketing and Communications Manager

Human Resource Agencies were authorized by Chapter 289 of the Public Acts of 1973 and operates under the authority of the amended TCA Title 13 Chapter 26. Nine (9) HRA's function within the same geographic area as development districts which encompasses all 95 counties in Tennessee. By this legislation, Human Resource Agencies are directed to be the primary service deliverer for the Department of Human Services.
