Human Resource Agencies were authorized by Chapter 289 of the Public Acts of 1973 and operates under the authority of the amended TCA Title 13 Chapter 26. Nine (9) HRA's function within the same geographic area as development districts which encompasses all 95 counties in Tennessee. By this legislation, Human Resource Agencies are directed to be the primary service deliverer for the Department of Human Services.

ETHRA's designated service delivery area is the sixteen counties of:
Anderson, Blount, Campbell, Claiborne, Cocke, Grainger, Hamblen, Jefferson
Knox, Loudon, Monroe, Morgan, Roane, Scott, Sevier, Union; with programs in additional
counties of: Bradley, Bledsoe, Grundy, Hamilton, Marion, Polk, Rhea and Sequatchie.
Currently, ETHRA has more than 40 programs which includes Public Transportation. ETHRA's
corporate office is located at 9111 Cross Park Drive, Suite D-100, Knoxville, TN 37923. ETHRA's
services extend across more than 16 counties in East Tennessee and offices are located in
each county. Although there are many services offered in each county, most of our program
personnel are located in Knoxville.

The ETHRA Board consists of the sixteen (16) County Mayors/Executives, three (3) Municipal Mayors selected by the County Mayors/Executives and two (2) members of the General Assembly. The Board meets each second Tuesday of each month at the ETHRA Corporate office in Knoxville, Tennessee.
