Accurate records are important for many reasons and TN OSHA expects employers to comply with the rules for keeping records that truly reflect workplace injuries and illnesses.

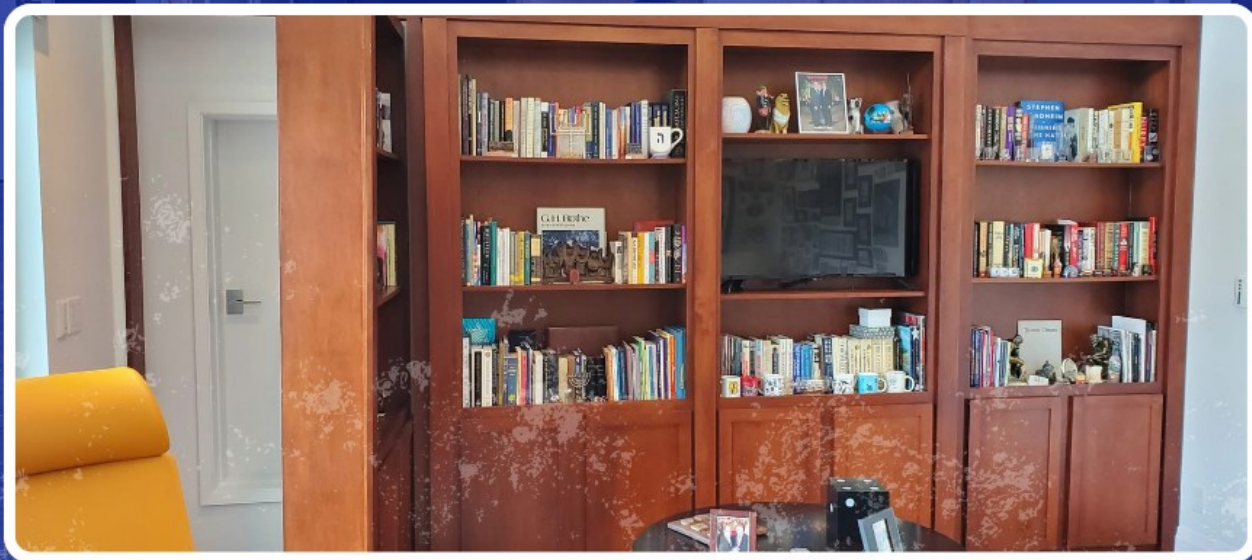

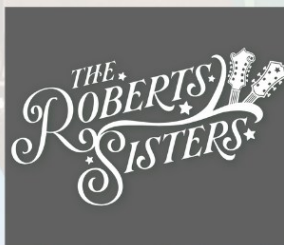

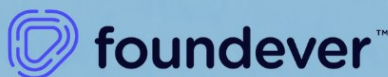
