### Tennessee State Chamber to Offer Recordkeeping 300 Log / TOSHA workshop in Morristown September 10

Many people are not sure how to complete the OSHA 300 forms correctly.

Accurate records are important for many reasons and TN OSHA expects employers to comply with the rules for keeping records that truly reflect workplace injuries and illnesses.

At this seminar, the student will get the information needed to record cases correctly, and will learn when cases should not be recorded.

Accurate data should also be used effectively in your facility to help maintain a safe and healthy workplace.

This seminar provides practical hands-on training and information on the record-keeping system and the OSHA 300 log. The seminar will also define the requirements for electronically reporting injury and illness data.


