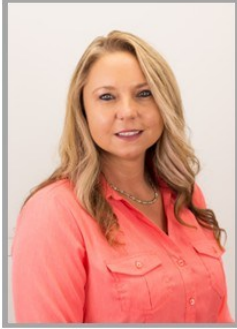
Fourteen Community Leaders Complete Leadership Morristown 2025 Program
