


Don't Miss YOUR Opportunity

2026 TOURISM MARKETING GRANT

Do you plan a festival or event in Morristown/Hamblen County? Do you need some financial assistance marketing that festival or event? Does your event attract visitors from **outside** the county as well as residents? If the answer is yes, you may be eligible for this grant program from the Chamber's tourism department. Organizations could receive up to \$1,000 to assist in marketing their festival or event.

Some uses for grant funds include, but are not limited to photography and videography, marketing and promotional materials, new or expanded enhancements (programming and activities, entertainment, hands-on experiences).




